As I sit here, watching Nikki cutting the hair of the youngest one to join the survivor sisterhood, I am amazed at where the Lord has brought us in the past few months since you heard from me for an update.

This has been a season where seeds previously planted were given the space and the nutrients to began to flourish.

Nikki has continued to work with a mentor and is growing into an amazing advocate and leader. We even see her share her princess tiara when she sees another needs to wear it for a while.

Our group is working hard to remove any weeds that hinder our growth and it has been strenuous but productive work. We are holding ourselves and each other accountable to growth and continuously referring back to our binders from our DISC and Emotional Intelligence workshop. (For example if you remind Mariah when she interrupts you - she really will not get mad, she wants you to tell her so she can continue to learn awareness).

That hard work paid off this morning when a judge looked at Donna and granted her visits with her son, after 3 long years. That hard work echoed in that court room as person after person who once stood firmly opposed to Donna's contact with her son, not only acknowledged her transformation, but agreed that Donna was inspiring to them and should see her son. THEY petitioned for her. GOD petitioned for her.

That hard work they are doing as individuals and as a team, mixed with nights of crafts and laughter, has brought us to today where I sit watching Nikki show God's love to a little sister that is being embraced. Where she once saw only fear displayed, she is seeing hope in the lived experience of those that are choosing to heal and walk in freedom. Those like Donna, Nikki and Mariah.
