# Update on our Survivors

So much of our daily lives revolve around food. We meet around food. We build relationships, laugh, and cry over food. We share life events - the happy ones and the sad - over food. I think that it would be fair to say that a large part of our life experiences revolve around meals.



At Peace Promise, we are also reminded that a meal can heal. One of our newest friends just experienced Chick-fil-A for the first time. As we sat in the parking lot looking at the menu before getting in line to order, she was overwhelmed. "I really want to try the sandwich, but my friend said the nuggets and sauce are amazing." And then she added: "You know I've never had to do this before? Choose food that I want to eat." We pulled away from the drive thru with both a sandwich and nuggets in the bag (and a milkshake) and headed to the Loft.

As she picked a Netflix movie to watch and snuggled in for the afternoon, she shared that "he" would order food for himself and two others in the home, but never for those that were under his control. This was not a random, one time thing. This was a daily thing. She said "we never knew if we would eat, and if we did it always came with ... well, you already know Ms. Patty...a price." Yes, sadly we know the cost you had to pay to eat. But never again.

Groceries purchased, homemade meals arriving for groups, drive-thru runs at lunchtime as we handle appointments, and meal experiences that never come at a cost for survivors. These all create safety in areas where basic need vulnerabilities have been highly exploited.
