I am not even sure how another month has already passed but it was a big one! On March 7th I had the honor of baptizing Donna into the Kingdom of God. As she came out of the water, she was met with a new life that once again includes those most important to her in the physical. Her son, her brother, her sister-in-law, her nieces and nephews, her church family, and her Peace Promise family.

Less than a week later, we were sitting, arms linked together tightly, as the judge made his ruling on the father of her son. His rights were terminated. In that moment, we saw another layer of weight lift off Donna as God severed the ties, in the physical and spiritual, to the man who has done so much harm over the years. Donna is truly experiencing freedom for the first time in her life and it is overflowing to all around her.

Our youngest was placed in a new foster home where she is feeling stable, and, in God's sense of humor, the foster home is a block away from my house.

And finally, our Miss K is finding her confidence and, in that, her voice. She has been working extra hard on therapy and mindset change. She has been pushing herself to face fear and try new things. She is finding that she prefers to be celebrated for successes over being coddled from trauma. Now, she is speaking up for herself and starting to ask the hard questions of those who missed the mark with her.

Last night, as everyone was still in the room an hour after group was done laughing, sharing, and processing together, Becca and I said, "It really doesn't get better than this." And it really doesn't.



I will end with a personal note this month. I have spent the past week sharing with my immediate family, our survivors, and our team, that I am once again facing a battle with cancer. Though we currently have more questions than answers about what is happening in my physical body, we are trusting God and are going to tackle this as we do everything else. As a community.
